Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Updates

New England Milfoil's DASH boat crew has worked three weeks on Horseshoe Pond this summer and is slated to spend two weeks on Upper Pleasant Pond in September and early October. DASH means "diver assisted suction harvester" – a diver pulls plants from the bottom and feeds them into a suction hose which pumps them into a collecting bin on the surface. DASH boats are most efficient where dense stands of AIS, such as variable leaf milfoil, occur. Many thanks to those of you who hosted the DASH crew!
